

New: Concept of Broad Consent

- Consent for collection, maintenance and storage of identifiable data/specimens for future research
- Includes standard consent elements plus additional elements related to what can be done with data/specimens and how they will be stored

Broad Consent Considerations

- If Broad Consent is declined by a subject, then the IRB **cannot** waive consent to use subject's data/specimens
- Logistics of tracking consent and subjects' preferences extremely problematic
- With Broad Consent, more research may qualify for Exempt categories 7 & 8
- CHOP's IRB not currently planning to implement a separate Broad Consent
